COURSE CONTENT AND ASSESSMENT

You will develop your technique, artistic understanding and overall fitness to prepare you for a career in professional dance, circus & musical theatre performance and/or teaching.

You'll gain experience of a range of specialisms such Aerial Hoop, Silks and Trapeze, Musical Theatre (including singing, drama and audition technique) and Dance all of which will develop you as a versatile artist. In addition, you'll study core units linked to professional dance and musical theatre practice including the study of performing arts business, the investigation into practitioner's work, group performance workshops and performing in the community.

You will be assessed in many ways including exams, controlled assessments, video evidence of your training and practical performances, assessor witness testimonies, work diary and log books, peer observations, self-assessments, written reports, assignments and work experience.
